

Happy Mother's Day Coasters



Hoop: 180mm x 130mm

Stitches: 14,208

Colors: 10

Width: 169.7mm

Length: 128.5mm

Items needed for Coaster

Quilt Batting: 5½ x 7 inches

Fabric:

2 Pieces 7½ x 6 inches, Top and Bottom. (Same or Different Colors)

Embroidery Thread:

Wind a bobbin the same color as the thread used for the Satin Border.

Stabilizer: "Wash-Away"

1 piece large enough to hoop in the 180mm x 130mm hoop.


Embroidery Hoop: 180mm x 130mm or Larger (5 x 7 inches)

Scotch Tape

Appliqué Scissors or Sharp Curved Scissors


*You don't have to change the thread **10** times. Thread colors are used to prompt your embroidery machine to stop after each step. Start with a thread color that matches your fabric.*

Hoop the Stabilizer



1 Lay the Batting over the outline.


Color 1: Sew the placement stitch for the Quilt Batting.



2 Trim close to the stitches. Lay the **Top** 7½ x 6 inch piece of fabric on top of the Batting.




Color 2: Sew the Batting. **Trim**



3 **Do Not Trim.**




Color 3: Sew the fabric in place.



4 **Color 4:** Sew the Crosshatch.

Color 6: Sew the Leaf border.



Color 7:

Sew "Happy Mother's Day". Remove the Hoop. Lay the **Bottom** fabric, (7½ x 6 inch), face up. Make sure the Stitches are covered. Tape the corners to secure in place. Replace the Hoop.


Color 8: Sew. Remove the Hoop.



Trim the Front and Back close to the edges.


Replace the Hoop.

Change the **top** and **bottom** thread to matching colors for the next step.



Color 9: Sew the Satin stitch.

Change the top thread to an accent color for the Decorative stitch.

Color 10: Sew the Decorative

Remove the hoop. Cut around the Coaster to remove it from the Hoop. Trim as close as possible to the stitches. Remove the excess Stabilizer by wetting your finger and rubbing along the edges. If you make it too wet, it will cause the fabric to pucker and wrinkle. If that happens you will have to soak the coaster to dissolve all the stabilizer inside.
