

Fall Pumpkin Sign



Hoop: 180mm x 130mm

Stitches: 15,151

Colors: 12

Width: 128.8. mm

Length: 148.4mm

Items needed:

Quilt Batting: 5 x 6 inches

Fabric: 2 Pieces 6 x 7 inches, Top and Bottom. (Same or Different Colors)

Stabilizer: “Tear-Away”

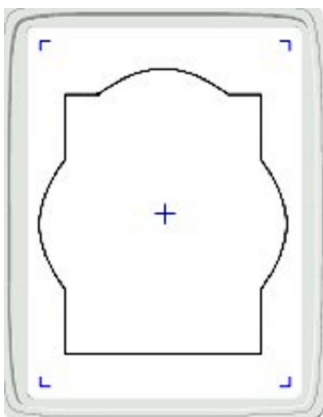
Embroidery Hoop: 180mm x 130mm or Larger (5 x 7 inches)

12 to 15 inches of Cord or Ribbon (Beads Optional)

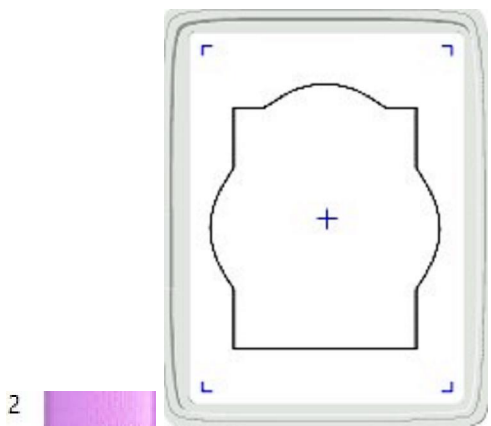
Scotch Tape

You don't have to change the thread **12** times. Thread colors are used to prompt your embroidery machine to stop after each step. Start with a thread color that matches your fabric.

Hoop the Stabilizer

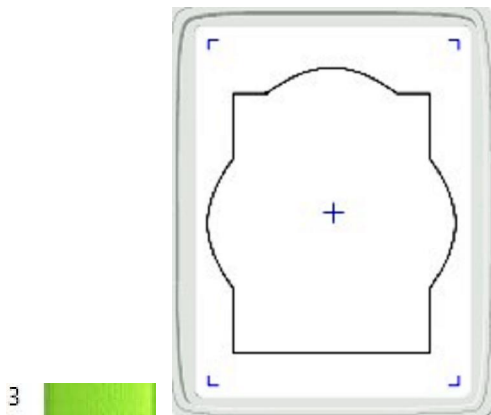


1 **Color 1:** Sew the placement stitch for the Quilt Batting. Lay the Batting over the outline.

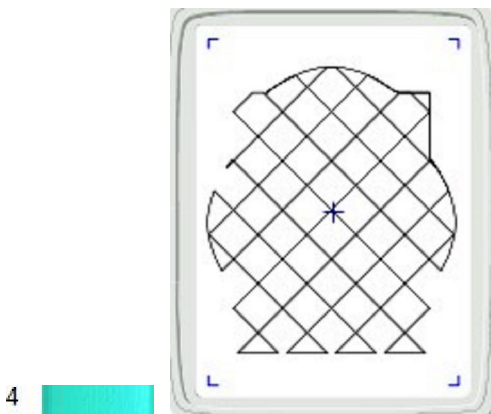


Color 2:

Sew the Batting. Trim close to the stitches. Lay the **Top 6 x 7** inch piece of fabric over the Batting.



Color 3: Sew the fabric. **Don't Trim.**



Color 4: Sew the Crosshatch.



Colors 5-10: Sew the **Design.**

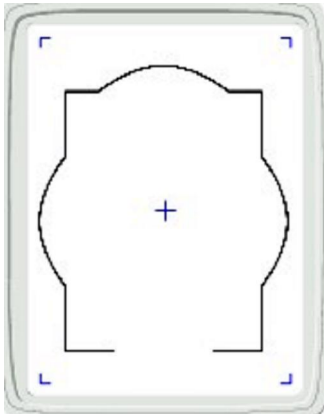


Color 11: Sew **WELCOME FALL**.

Mark 3/8 inch from each side for the placement of the cord. Tape each end to the fabric with the ends facing out.



Lay the **Bottom** fabric, (6 x 7 inch), face down over the top. Tape the corners to make sure it doesn't shift. Make sure the cord is out of the way.

Color 12: Sew

the bottom. Remove from the Hoop. Trim around the edges 1/4 inch except at the bottom opening. Clip the curves. Turn to right side. Push out the corners. Press if needed. Glue or stitch the opening closed.
